Scorecard respondents receive an e-mail after they submit their responses using the online Scorecard submission system. This provides their own score and contributes to the average of all employers in the database. We update these averages on a regular basis to reflect new respondents completing the Scorecard.

The table and figures below provide information based on the 637 unique organizations that completed the US version of the Scorecard as of December 31, 2016. This information will become available for the International version once enough responses have been collected to develop a normative database.
